Time commitment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ School visits usually take place during term times, weekdays (Monday to Thursday) between 10-12pm ○ Scout visits usually take place in the evening from 5-7pm ○ Some occasional weekend commitments may be required
Required/Desired Skills & Qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Enthusiastic individuals who see the value of dawah to young people from our local communities ○ Strong communication skills are essential for effectively liaising with teachers, parents, students, and external organizations involved in the visits. Keep audience engaged ○ The ability to communicate effectively with the Visits Co-Ordinator and other volunteers ○ Organisational skills ○ A commitment to regular attendance ○ A DBS Certificate will be provided free (essential)
