Key Responsibilities	 Assist during scout and school visits alongside other volunteers (at least three) at the masjid to either: Conduct a presentation on the 5 pillars of Islam (presentation provided) Demonstrate wudu (ablution) process Provide insights about the Quran Demonstrate Adhan and or Salah (prayer) Ensuring the needs of special needs visitors are attended to Answer questions about Islam from groups of children (up to thirty at a time) aged 4 to 16 proficiently and in age appropriate way
Time commitment	 School visits usually take place during term times, weekdays (Monday to Thursday) between 10-12pm Scout visits usually take place in the evening from 5-7pm Some occasional weekend commitments may be required
Required/Desired Skills & Qualifications	 Enthusiastic individuals who see the value of dawah to young people from our local communities Strong communication skills are essential for effectively liaising with teachers, parents, students, and external organizations involved in the visits. Keep audience engaged The ability to communicate effectively with the Visits Co-Ordinator and other volunteers Organisational skills A commitment to regular attendance A DBS Certificate will be provided free (essential)
