

Job Title	Volunteers, School and Scouts Visits Team
Key Responsibilities	<ul> <li>Assist during scout and school visits alongside other volunteers (at least three) at the masjid to either:</li> <li>Conduct a presentation on the 5 pillars of Islam (presentation provided)</li> <li>Demonstrate wudu (ablution) process</li> <li>Provide insights about the Quran</li> <li>Demonstrate Adhan and or Salah (prayer)</li> <li>Ensuring the needs of special needs visitors are attended to</li> <li>Answer questions about Islam from groups of children (up to thirty at a time) aged 4 to 16 proficiently and in age appropriate way</li> </ul>
Time commitment	<ul> <li>School visits usually take place during term times, weekdays (Monday to Thursday) between 10-12pm</li> <li>Scout visits usually take place in the evening from 5-7pm</li> <li>Some occasional weekend commitments may be required</li> </ul>
Required/Desired Skills & Qualifications	<ul> <li>Enthusiastic individuals who see the value of dawah to young people from our local communities</li> <li>Strong communication skills are essential for effectively liaising with teachers, parents, students, and external organizations involved in the visits. Keep audience engaged</li> <li>The ability to communicate effectively with the Visits Co-Ordinator and other volunteers</li> <li>Organisational skills</li> <li>A commitment to regular attendance</li> <li>A DBS Certificate will be provided free (essential)</li> </ul>
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
